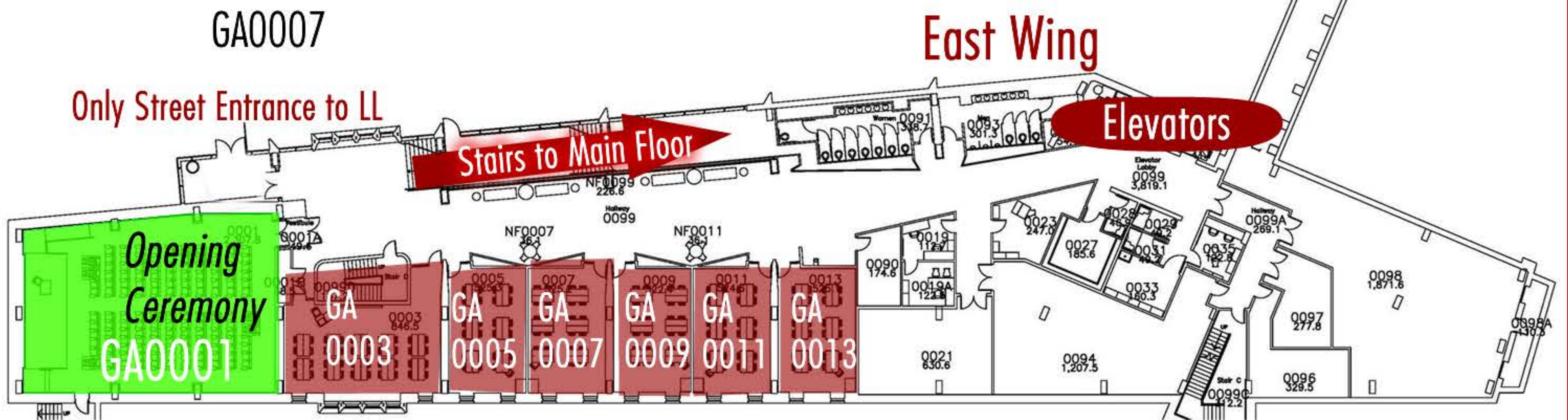

Floor Plan

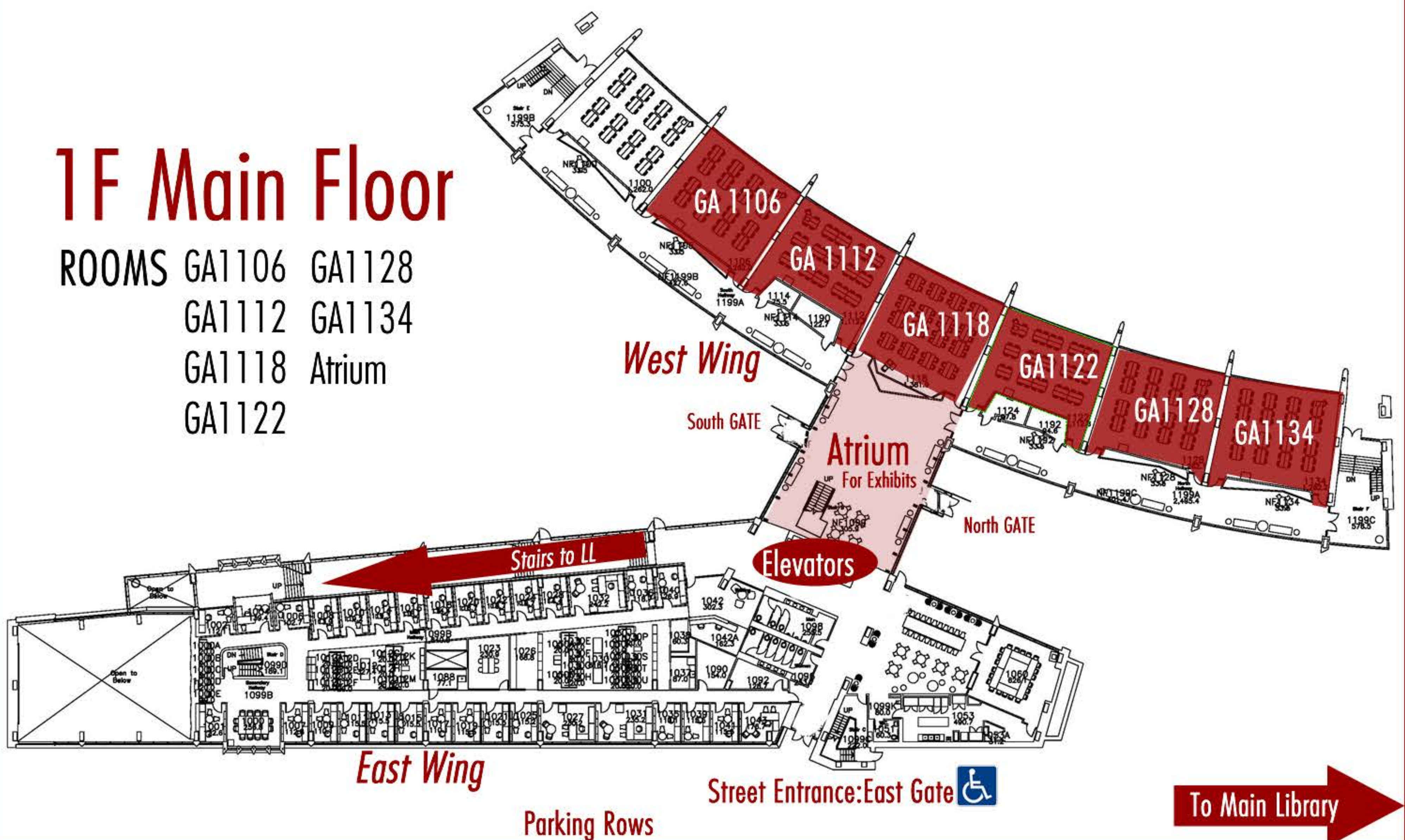
