

Breakfast Culture in China

Every country has its own breakfast style and special dishes, and China is no exception! One of the most notable differences between Chinese and Western cuisine is breakfast. In this lesson, we are going to talk about what Chinese people usually have for breakfast, how breakfast options and preferences vary significantly from north to south, and why there is such a big regional difference. 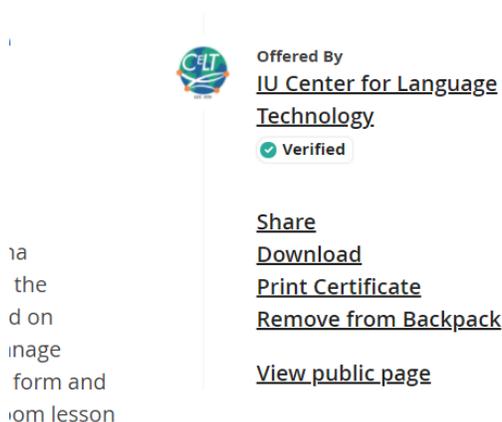
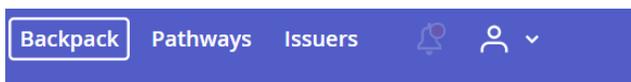

(This email will direct you to the Canvas Credentials website to view your badges.)

If you don't have a Canvas Credentials account yet, the website will guide you through setting one up. (It takes all of two minutes.) Be sure to use the same email address with which you registered for the Canvas course.

Once in your account, the badge should appear in your "Backpack." Open it, and you'll see options to share with a public link, share on social (LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest) and share in HTML. You can also download it as a PNG image or print it in certificate form.



However, there is no need to go to an external site. You can simply check your badge progress at any time **in Canvas** in the [Credentials](#) tab:

- It shows you which badges you have and haven't earned, and which pathways you have and haven't completed.

- You should see something like this as a student:

Pathways

- Pathways are a way to share your progress in a course beyond just sharing each individual badge.
- Essentially, a pathway is a **sequence of earned badges**.
- The two pathways we offer in the World Language Festival Virtual Academy are **Jetsetter** and **World Language & Culture**.

1. Jetsetter Pathway

This pathway consists of 3 sequential “milestone” badges:

Badge	Criteria
Global Sightseer 	Complete lessons in at least 3 different languages
Globetrotter 	Complete lessons in at least 6 different languages

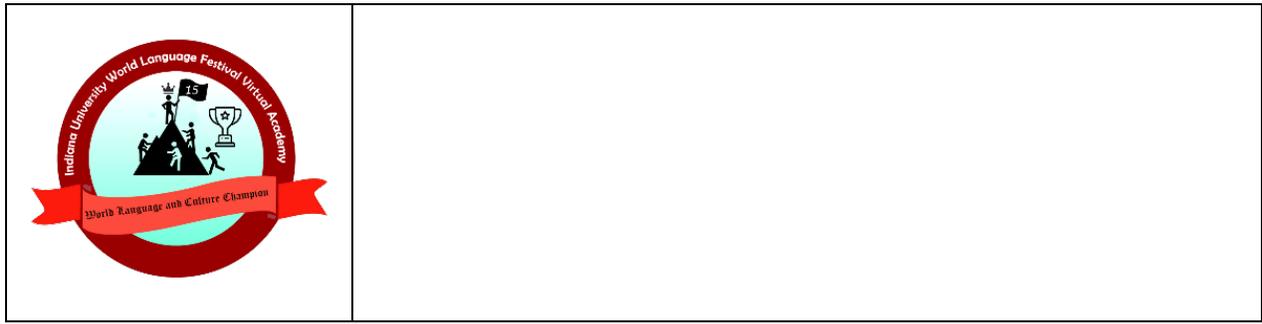
<p>Jetsetter</p> 	<p>Complete lessons in at least 10 different languages</p>
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(The WLF Virtual Academy currently offers lessons in **16** languages!)

2. World Language & Culture Pathway

This pathway consists of 3 sequential “milestone” badges:

Badge	Criteria
<p>World Language & Culture Challenger</p> 	<p>Earn 5 badges, in any order, and in any combination of languages.</p>
<p>World Language & Culture Conqueror</p> 	<p>Earn 10 badges, in any order, and in any combination of languages.</p> <p>(Note: the 5 badges for the Challenger badge count towards the 10 needed for the Conqueror badge.)</p>
<p>World Language & Culture Champion</p>	<p>Earn 15 badges, in any order, and in any combination of languages.</p> <p>(Note: the 10 badges for the Conqueror badge count towards the 10 needed for the Champion badge.)</p>

- Go to the [Credentials](#) tab in the Canvas course.
- Scroll down to “My pathway progress” at the bottom (below example using my own, but yours should look similar except that no pathways will be completed):
